

2010 DRRL races and county championship events

For those of you who may have seen the phrase DRRL banded around but haven't a clue what it relates to, this is the Dorset Road Running League. There are 12 races each year and in order to qualify for an end of year position, you must have completed in a minimum of 7. Same rules apply for team standings : 7/12. If you complete in more than 7 then your best 7 finishing positions within the women from Dorset registered clubs will count. There are then end of year prizes for the top 3 individuals in the whole of the league, highest placed runner from each club and for the highest placed runner in each 5 year age group so plenty up for grabs. The best prize of all is the Fidelity award, tough to achieve and prized by a few from our club - this is awarded to those who compete and finish in all 12 races during the year. Basically, the Fidelity is out of the window if you don't run on New Years Day so what better New Years resolution!?

The county championship events take place within the same races and you don't need to do anything else in order to be eligible other than run in the race as a fully paid up BJ!!
